Section IV: The District Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause notice to be given of said Annual District Election and Budget Hearing in the form prescribed above, by publishing the Notice four times within the seven weeks next preceding such Annual District Election, the first publication to be at least forty-five days prior to the said Annual District Election, in *Newsday* and *The Herald*, two newspapers having general circulation in said School District, and by giving such other notice as, in her discretion, may be deemed desirable.
