Section 1. The Board of Education of the Malverne Union Free School District (the "School District") has received seven (7) proposals from firms to provide financing under the Energy Performance Contract that the School District has heretofore entered into with Johnson Controls, Inc. (the "Agreement") with respect to (i) the \$3,899,338 cost of the energy conservation measures to be implemented (the "Equipment") and, (ii) in the event of approval by the New York State Education Department ("SED Approval"), the \$335,000 cost of the installation of solar panels (the "Additional Equipment").

Section 2. Following a discussion of the Board of Education of the School District, and based upon the

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written recommendation received from Capital Markets Advisors, LLC, the School District's Financial Advisor, it is hereby determined that (i) with respect to the Equipment, the proposal of Banc of America Public Capital Corp, or one of its affiliates (the "Lessor"), reflecting tax-exempt financing at an interest rate of 2.1350% over a term of 15 years is the lowest responsible proposal in the best interest of the School District, and (ii) in the event of SED Approval and with respect to the Additional Equipment, the proposal of Banc of America Public Capital Corp, or one of its affiliates (the "Lessor"), reflecting tax-exempt financing at an interest rate of 2.210% over a term of 15 years is the lowest responsible proposal in the best interest of the School District, and such proposal are hereby accepted subject to the negotiation of a lease purchase agreements) approved by counsel.

Section 3. The President of the Board of Education, the Vice President of the Board of Education, Superintendent of Schools and/or the Assistant Superintendent for Busicess (collectively the "Authorized Representatives" and man idually, the "Authorized Representative") acting on chalf of the School District and with the advice of counsel, are hereby authorized to negotiate, enter into, execute, and aliver one or more lease purchase agreements (collectively the "Equipment Lease") with the Lease The Authorized Representatives are hereby further authorized with the advice of counsel to negotiate, enter into, execute, and diversuch other doments relating the Equipment Lease (including, but not kinded to, escroy agreements) as the Authorized Representatives deem agreements necessary and appropriate. All other related contracts and agreements necessary and middless and contracts and agreements necessary and middless. Shall be filed in the office of the District Clerk and made available for public inspection.

ction 4) The aggregate original principal amount of the hapipment Lease with respect to the Equipment shall not exceed \$3,899,338 and the aggregate original principal amount of the Equipment Lease with respect to the Additional Equipment shall not exceed \$335,000, and each shall bear interest as set forth in the Equipment Lease and shall contain such options for prepayment as set forth therein.

Section 5. The School District's obligations under the Equipment Lease shall be subject to annual appropriation or renewal by the Board of Education of the School District as set forth in each Equipment Lease and the School District's obligations under the Equipment Lease shall not constitute a general obligation of the School District or indebtedness under the Constitution or laws of the State of New York.

Section 6. The proceeds of the Equipment Lease may be applied to reimburse the School District for expenditures made after the effective date of this resolution for the

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purpose for which said proceeds are authorized, or on or prior to such date if the Board of Education of the School District has adopted a prior statement of intent to issue bonds for such purpose. The foregoing statement of intent with respect to reimbursement is made in conformity with Treasury Regulation Section 1.150-2 of the United States Treasury Department.

Section 7. The Authorized Representatives are hereby authorized to take any and all other actions necessary in connection with the Agreement, the Equipment Lease, and all matters related thereto.

Section 8. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
